

AUTHOR GUIDELINES FOR OBITUARIES IN GEOTECHNIQUE

Obituary Title:

- Full name of the Deceased
- Year range (Birth and death years)

Content – Main Text:

The main text should not exceed 1, 500 words and must include the following:

- Contributor(s) name, affiliation

Information about the Deceased:

- A brief family background
- Academic/Work history
- Accolades/Achievements
- Contribution to the field of geotechnical engineering – justifying the deceased person's place in Geotechnique

Content – References/Publication Details:

Up to 20 key publications of the deceased can be cited

- The Harvard referencing style should be followed, see references guidelines below <http://www.icevirtuallibrary.com/upload/reference.pdf>
- If required, contributors can contact the ICE Archivist, Carol Morgan (carol.morgan@ice.org.uk) for cross checking any data/information

Mandatory Enclosures for Authors in Addition to the Text:

- One suitable photograph of the deceased, please try to avoid using group photos. However, if group photos are being used, please provide an appropriate caption
- Journals Publishing Agreement to be completed by the contributors before articles are published. Please download the form by clicking <http://www.icevirtuallibrary.com/upload/jnlcopyright.pdf>
